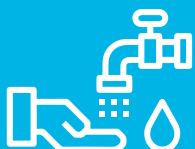

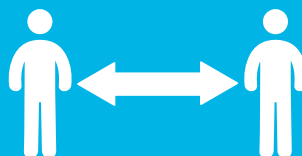
STAYING SAFE DURING THE RACE

STAGING

Staging corrals prior to your start are assigned by pace and set up to maintain state-mandated social distancing protocols. In each corral, there will be restrooms, water, hand sanitizer, and extra face coverings to ensure convenience once you get into your designated staging corral.



Mask Required in Corral Staging Areas

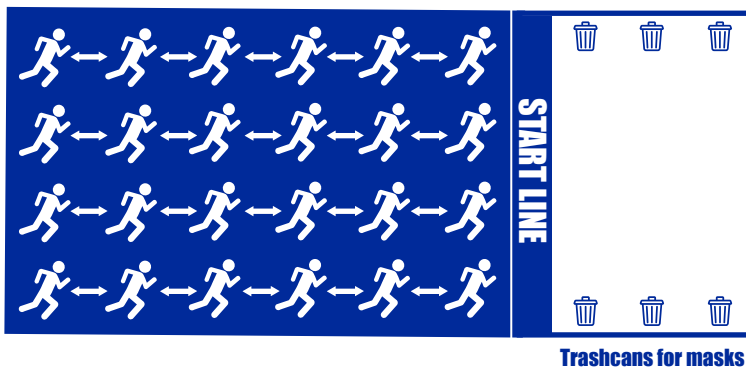


Water Station Locations



START

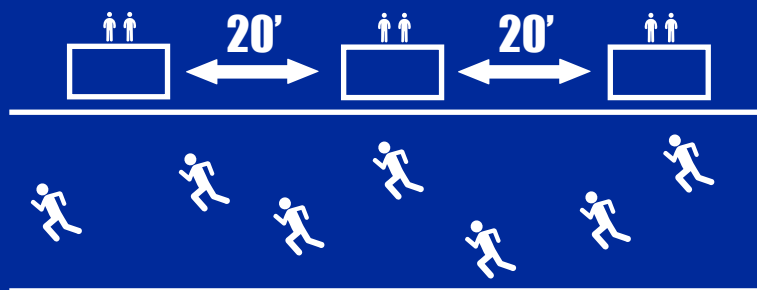
MASK REQUIRED AT START



Athletes will be called out of their staging corrals by the announcer and event staff to proceed to the starting line. Athletes will start with a Time Trial Format with 4 athletes starting every 10 seconds. Athletes will be directed to stand on the course markings on the street to ensure social distancing protocols of 6 feet between runners in this area before the start.

ON COURSE SUPPORT

When athletes approach the Aid Station, they will notice water and Gatorade tables separated by at least 20 feet. Cups of both water and Gatorade will be available on all tables. Event staff and volunteers will be at each Aid Station for athlete convenience and support



FINISH

- New face coverings will be provided once athletes cross the finish line. You must put on your new face covering before exiting the “Post Event Mask Zone”!
- Spectators are NOT ALLOWED in this area!
- Maintain Social Distancing of at least 6 feet in this area and in the Post Event Area next to the Mississippi State Supreme Court Building on High Street.
- Prepackaged Food Items, Bottled Water, and Bottled Gatorade will be in the post-event area next to the Mississippi State Supreme Court Building on High Street.
- Race Event Marshals and Security will be on site in the Post Event Area to ensure that NO GATHERINGS of over 10 people are taking place at this location.
- Face Coverings for athletes and spectators in the Post Event Area are REQUIRED at all times!
